Joint Commissioner, Commercial Tax (SIB) Zone-B, Allahabad has sent a Notice to us to appear in the above matter (Copy of notice is enclosed at Annexure-II) in person & substantiate our so-called "complaint". We have received this notice with reference to our letter No.2b/7685, dt. 4.4.2009 (Copy enclosed at Annexure – I), wherein we submitted a case of unlawful detention of a vehicle to you and now compliance of the Commissioner, Commercial Tax Circular by the field officer.

Your good self is aware that we have no complaining temperament, but we interact & request the H.O.D. & Govt. on legal and policy matters, procedural circulars & wherever needed cite specific instances to convey to your goodself the repeated deviations pursued by field officers.

IIA will look forward to your goodself to peruse the matter in depth and see why field officers drag the matters of Registered Dealers only in seizures net. We simply request that the commitments given to Industries may kindly be protected and field officers may be advised to honour the Commissioners Circulars.

Under the circumstances and facts of the case stated above we are not attending Allahabad and seek your intervention in the matter as requested in our letter dated 4.4.2009.
