Urgent issues/proposals related to industrial development in the State, submitted to Industrial Development Commissioner, U.P.

Since the swearing in of the New Government in Uttar Pradesh, IIA have brought few urgent issues/proposals to the notice of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Cabinet Secretary and Secretary to C.M. related to industrial development in the State. We are reproducing these and few more as under for your kind information, consideration and necessary action:-

1	Implementation of VAT	-	Announcement should may be made urgently and be implemented before Oct. 2007
2	Formal Launch of Web-Enabled Single Table System	-	With your guidance and encouragements the system is designed and developed by IIA. However it is not being implemented properly. We propose that a formal launch of the System by the CM may be expedited at the earliest.
3	Strengthening of Udyog Bandhu	-	Open House meetings atleast once in 3 months under the Chairpersonship of the Chief Minister may help a lot.
4	Laghu Udyami Mahasammelan	-	Once a year jointly by Govt. of UP and IIA will boost this vital sector in the State.
5	Seminar on Self Sufficiency in Power generation	-	The biggest infrastructure bottleneck for industries in U.P. is shortage of power. The demand & supply gap is increasing day by day. We need to reverse the process. As such we propose that a Seminar jointly by Deptt of Industrial Development, Department of Power and IIA be organized in 1 st week of August 07. Out come of this Seminar may then be followed by a task force once in three months.

6	Effective Re-habilitation & Exit Policy for MSME	-	Is being discussed for long. Yet to be finalized.
7	Creation and Maintenance of Industrial Data in the State	-	Authentic data on industries in U.P is not available any where. IIA propose to create & maintain such data regularly with the support of Industrial Development Department. A pilot Survey has already been done by IIA in Lucknow.
