

MSME Ministry notifies one-page Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum

NEW DELHI: MSME Ministry has come out with a one-page Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum which must be filled online by all micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs), a move that will simplify registration procedure for entrepreneurs and promote ease of doing business.

It has been further specified that in case online filing is not possible, a hard copy could also be submitted to the District Industry Centre, which would file the memorandum online on their behalf. It has further been specified that there shall be no fee for filing the Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum by the MSMEs.

The Udyog Aadhaar Acknowledgement shall be generated and mailed at the email address provided in the Memorandum which will contain a unique Udyog Aadhaar Number.

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filed Entrepreneurship Memorandum-I or Entrepreneurship Memorandum-II before coming force of the MSME ACT 2006, shall not be required to file the Aadhaar Number. The memorandum shall be filed

on self declaration basis and would need no supporting document. But the Central Government, the State Government, or such person as may be authorized in this behalf may seek documentary proof of
