**Subject: Request for extension of date for depositing Electricity Bills due to extension of Lockdown Period**

Sir,

We refer to your orders vide Letter No 216 Dated 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2020 (copy attached for ready reference) wherein you were kind enough to extend the date for depositing Electricity Bills by Industries by 30<sup>th</sup> April 2020 in view of the Lock Down announce by Hon'ble Prime Minister from 25<sup>th</sup> March to 14<sup>th</sup> April 2020. The Lock Down period has now been further extended till 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2020 and industries are not allowed to operate in Hot Spot & Restricted Areas. In other areas also the industries are either not able to launch the production or are operating at very low capacity utilization.

In view of the situation stated above , it is requested that the date for depositing Electricity bills without any surcharge may be extended till 31st May 2020 and the fixed Charges may also be waived off for the period of Lockdown i.e 25<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2020.
